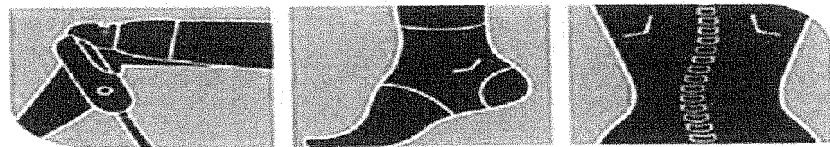



A TRIBUTE TO IAN DIXON

Ian Dixon passed away on the 09th November 2011. After his death, the following report was published in our local newspaper “The Natal Witness”:
“LOCAL SPORTS LEGEND IAN DIXON DIES

Pietermaritzburg banker and sportsman, Ian Dixon died early yesterday morning, aged 78, after a long illness. Born in Durban and schooled at Maritzburg College, Dixon was district manager of First National Bank for the Midlands region for 12 years until his retirement. Dixon played cricket for SA Schools, SA Country districts and Natal Currie Cup teams as well as league squash. He was known nationally for his contributions to cricket and squash as an administrator and historian. Dixon was a member of the most prestigious cricket club in the world, Marylebone Cricket Club (MCC) at Lords in London; the historian for Squash South Africa; the President of KZN Squash and for 52 years, a member of Collegians Squash Club. He was an ardent collector of memorabilia and one of his finest achievements was the establishment of the South African Squash Museum at Collegians Club. His remarkable knowledge as a cricket historian has contributed to the wealth of historical information housed at the Maritzburg Oval. Ian George Dixon leaves his wife, June, two daughters, four grandchildren and one great grandchild.”

I knew Ian as a personal friend for almost 40 years. We shared many memories and experiences – Round Table, Collegians Club, SA Jesters Squash, National and Provincial Squash committees. During his 7 month roller coaster battle with cancer, it was my privilege to visit him frequently and to appreciate his great loves and passions in life – his family, squash, cricket, cycads and classical music. In his personal library at home - well stocked with rare and valuable squash and cricket books – I began to appreciate his encyclopaedic knowledge of and passion for these sporting disciplines. Ian walked with giants. Legendary sporting figures – amongst others, Jackie McGlew, Roy Maclean, Pat Symcox, Geoff Hunt, Chris Dittmar – were his personal friends. In the squash world, his contribution was immense – so many, many articles, stories, anecdotes and one liners were published in tournament programmes down the years – Jarvis/Kaplan Cup, SA Masters and this our own Dave Short Inter Prov. He also organised a record number of Jarvis Cup Tournaments for which he received recognition from SA Squash.

Ian’s lovely sense of humour is reflected in many of his literary contributions. He always found something funny in life. Even in his last moments, in the shadow of death, when he could barely speak, his irrepressible sense of humour surfaced and he made some hilarious comment which made me chuckle – amazing! His wife, June, supported his passion for squash and cricket. She stored, packed and catalogued his memorabilia which she has now donated to the SA Squash Museum (known as Ian’s Corner) at Collegians Club. In time to come visitors will be able to follow the history of squash since its early beginnings at Harrow School, England and the Fleet Street prison –and through a display of rackets, squash shirts, scrap books and other memorabilia gain some insight to a remarkable squash enthusiast - IAN GEORGE DIXON.

MESSAGE FROM DAVE SHORT THE FOUNDER OF THE DAVE SHORT MASTERS SQUASH TOURNAMENT

In September 1987, three Midlands squash players attended the SA National Masters Singles Squash Tournament in Port Elizabeth as invited players. They were Terry Williams, Peter Maher and myself. Peter and I played for the Western Transvaal Mielie Boere team and Terry for South West Africa.

We had a festive time in Port Elizabeth and the Western Transvaalers invited Midlands to send a team to Klerksdorp in March 1988 to play in their Mielie Boere squash tournament. Midlands sent two teams, one ladies and one men's side, which tournament was then run by Johan Nagel and Jane Kassner, who is now living in Pietermaritzburg and is still playing squash.

On returning to Pietermaritzburg, we formed a Masters Squash committee (then known as Veterans Squash) with Jonathan Lowe as our Chairman. Our first Midlands tournament was to be held in June 1988. We only expected 8 or 10 teams but were delighted to find 18 teams (90 players) participating. All were given personalised T-shirts. On the Sunday, at the close of the tournament, we had lunch at Hilton College School and there were no trophies to award. Dave Barrow, (an ex Springbok squash player) said that they had all enjoyed it so much that trophies were not necessary, and it has remained that way to this day. The next year the lunch was held at Michaelhouse School and the following year back again at Hilton College School.

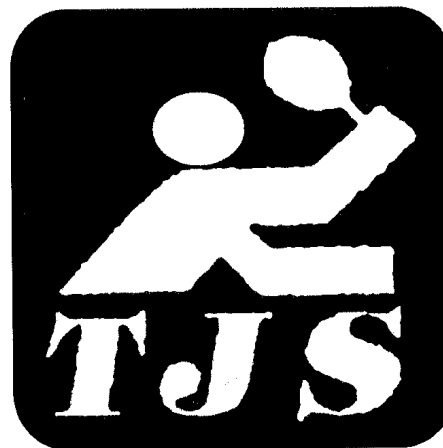
In the 4th year of the event (21 years ago) whilst we were having lunch at Michaelhouse School at the close of the tournament, Rob van Heerden who is back serving on the current committee, stood up and suggested that this tournament should be named after me in recognition of me having started the event. This was unanimously agreed to and later ratified by SSA. Since then the event grew to as many as 300 players but has today settled around the 250 mark which realistically is more manageable.

I am amazed and delighted with the popularity this event has enjoyed over all these years and can probably put it down to the dedication and commitment of the many committee members who have served on the organising committee's over all these years. For that I thank you as ultimately it is squash, a game that we all love and enjoy that has benefited, as well as many friendships we have made through this sport. Now in it's 25th year, my hope is that this event will continue to be enjoyed by many more squash players in the years ahead.

My sincere thanks to Mike Short, my son, and the Midlands and Dave Short committee's for running another successful event.

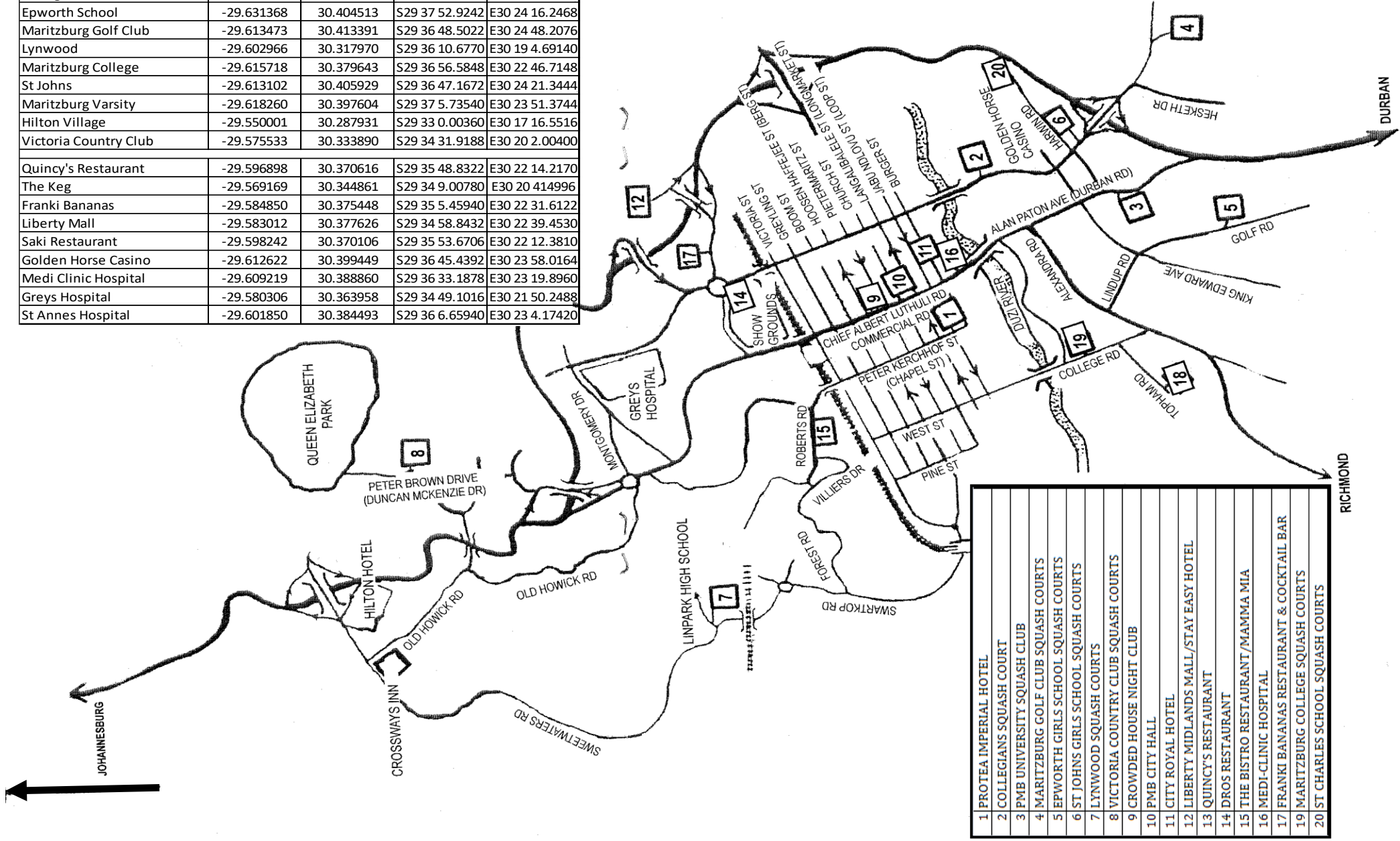
